

TRANSPORTING MEDICATIONS TO/FROM SCHOOL

- Please be aware that students are not to be transporting ANY medication to or from school.
- For safety reasons, an adult must bring medications to the clinic.
 Medications sent with students will not be administered.
- Proper paperwork must be on file for medication to be administered.
 - For over the counter medications: a signed parent permission form must be on file.
 - For prescription medications: a signed parent permission form <u>and</u> a doctor's note are required.
- All medications, including inhalers, must be in the original bottle/box with label and directions.
- These procedures are required by Indiana State Law. Medications will not be administered if the proper medication forms are not on file.
- Any medication administered by the school, with parent permission, will ONLY be dispensed based on manufacturer guidelines. ANY variation from this requires a written physician's order.
- Lastly, if your child has any unused medications left at school, these cannot be sent home with students. An adult must pick up the medication from the clinic.
