

If Your Child Becomes Ill

UPDATED PARENT/GUARDIAN CONTACT INFORMATION

It is **EXTREMELY** important that parents provide current contact phone numbers, address information, and emergency contact information to the school in case of an emergency for their child.

If your child becomes ill, or is injured at school, you or another responsible adult listed on the Emergency Contacts list will be called to pick the child up from school.

REPORTING YOUR CHILD'S ILLNESS TO THE SCHOOL

If your child is absent, please notify the school. **Office staff will ask for a description of your child's symptoms for the purpose of tracking illnesses within the school.**

RETURNING TO SCHOOL AFTER AN ILLNESS

We ask that students be **fever/vomit/diarrhea free WITHOUT THE USE OF MEDICATION FOR 24 HOURS** before returning. This is to ensure the health of all students.

CLINIC GUIDELINES FOR SENDING A STUDENT HOME FROM SCHOOL

Students will be sent home for persistent vomiting, fevers greater than 100 degrees, suspected pink eye, unidentified rashes, live head lice, or if the school health clinic personnel deem it necessary.

Please note: Once a child is at school, they are not to leave school due to illness without the permission of clinic staff. Under no circumstances are students to use personal cell phones or electronic devices to call/text parents to pick them up from school. Doing so will result in an unexcused absence and a disciplinary referral to the office. Your child's education is important to us, and being at school is vital to learning.

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
