SENIOR HIGH TRACK & FIELD ATHLETES

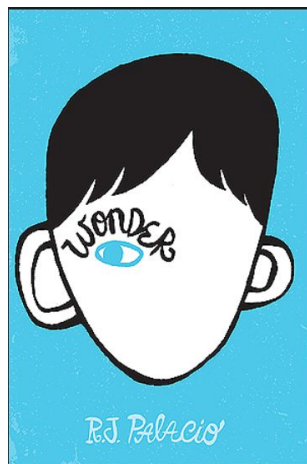

SWIM TEAM

The Boys and Girls Hagerstown Tiger shark swim and diving team traveled to Connersville last Thursday. Both teams were defeated by Connersville but represented the Tigers respectably. Hagerstown Boys 48-122 and Hagerstown girls 84-99.

The Boys team was led by junior Andrew Turner with a PR for the evening in 100 Butterfly at 1:08.99 placing 1st place. He also placed 2nd in the 200 IM. Senior, Tyler Wilson placed 1st in the 200 freestyle and 2nd place in the 100 breast. Both Tyler and Andrew were also part of the 200 Medley Relay and 200 Freestyle team that placed 2nd along with teammates Alexander McKee and James Cochran.

The girls team was defeated by Connersville only by 15 points. The girls were led by freshman Morgan Rector placing 1st in the 50 freestyle and 2nd place in the 100 freestyle. She was also a member of the 200 medley relay team that placed

1st. Her 200 Relay team members included Megan Callahan, Hailey Callahan, and Mallory Bledsoe. Also capturing a 1st place for the Tigers was diver Kortney Ridge with a dive score of 143.55.
