

JR. HIGH SWIMMING

The Hagerstown Jr. High Swim Team took home several first and second place finishes at their meet with Burriss on Thursday evening. Eighth grader Monika Perkins won first place in the 50

yard freestyle. Seventh grader Aaron Turner won first place in the 200 yard freestyle with a record breaking time of 2:10.00 (His second record of the season.) Eighth grader Bryce LaMar came in first in the 50 yard freestyle with a personal best time of 0:28.20.

Hagerstown had strong second place finishes in a number of events including the 200 Girls Medley Relay team consisting of Toni Callahan, Monika Perkins, Ava Neuman and Ruthie Hilbert; the 200 Boys Medley Relay Team consisting of Aaron Turner, Quaid Mull, Eli Bymaster and Bryce LaMar; Toni Callahan in the 100 IM and 100 Backstroke; Monika Perkins took in the Girls 50 fly with a time of 0:40.36; Brooke Stuart in the Girls 100 Yard Freestyle; Ava Neuman in the Girls 100 Breastroke; and Quaid Mull in the 100 Breastroke. Second place finishes were also earned by the Girls 200 Relay Team made up of Toni Callahan, Monika Perkins, Ava Neuman and Ruthie Hilbert and the Girls 400 Relay Team consisting of Anna Hoover, Lola Ullery, Brooke Stuart and Avery Schmitz.

The Boys 200 Relay team consisting of Quaid Mull, Eli Bymaster, Aaron Turner and Bryce LaMar took second place as well.

Although neither team won, several personal best times were recorded. The Jr. High Swim Team's next meet is **TONIGHT** night at Muncie Central. (This meet was rescheduled due to both schools having a snow day this past Wednesday.)
