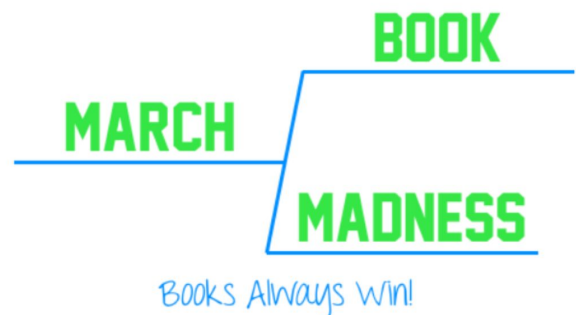
We will have one final call out **TODAY** after school in the cafeteria for any boy in grades 9-12 wanting to play baseball.
