# Tiger Results

## ARCHERY



After a very early start to the day, the Hagerstown Senior High Archery Team competed Saturday, March 9, at the state competition held at the Indiana State Fairgrounds.

This is the first time we have made it to state as a team since 2014-2015. At that time, we scored 2942 points with 57 - 10's or bullseyes. We finished 35th out of 39. This year we broke our school record. We scored 3118 points with 101 - 10's or bullseyes. We placed 31/36.

Our top 2 boy shooters shot a 275 ( only 5 points below the school competition record of 180) placing them in the 150 range out of 1107 boys competing. Our high scoring girl scored 263

placing her at 294/999. Eight of our archers scored their season and personal best at state competition.

## **JR HIGH SWIMMING**

### **Eastern Hancock Meet (March 4)**

The Boys Jr. High Swim team won their final meet Monday, March 4, against Eastern Hancock. Placing first was the Medley Relay team made up of Eli Bymaster (Backstroke), Quaid Mull (Breastroke), Aaron Turner (Butterfly), and Bryce LaMar (Freestyle). Alek Stuart took second place in the 200 Freestyle. The Tigers' Jackson Ward placed first in the 100 Yard I.M. with Carter Ramsey placing second. Bryce LaMar placed first in the 50 yard Freestyle and 100 yard Freestyle. Aaron Turner placed first in the 50 yard Butterfly followed by Jackson Ward placing second. The 200 Freestyle team made up of: Eli Bymaster,

Quaid Mull, Aaron Turner and Bryce LaMar also placed first, with the 200 Freestyle relay team made up of: Carter Ramsey, Evan Thornburg, Alek Stuart and Jackson Ward placing second. Evan Thornburg took second place in the 100 Backstroke. In the 100 Breaststroke, Aaron Turner took first place and Quaid Mull took second place. The 400 relay team consisting of: Carter Ramsey, Evan Thornburg, Alek Stuart and Jackson Ward went unopposed winning first place at the end of the meet.

The girls Jr. High Swim team lost to Eastern Hancock, but still had several strong finishes. Finishing first in the Medley Relay was a team made up of Toni Callahan (Backstroke), Monika Perkins (Butterfly), Ava Neuman (Breastroke) and Olivia Klein (Freestyle). Toni Callahan took second place in the 100 yard I.M. and first place in the 100 Backstroke. Monika Perkins took second place in the 50 yard Butterfly. In the 100 Freestyle, Olivia Klein took second place. Ava Neuman took second place in the 100 yard Breastroke.

At halftime the Jr. High Swim Team celebrated the completion of five eighth graders in the Jr. High Swimming program. They were each recognized and given a purple towel with their names embroidered: Anna Hoover, Eli Bymaster, Bryce LaMar, Quaid Mull and Monika Perkins.

### **New Castle Meet Results (Feb. 27)**

The Boys Jr. High Swim team had a very close match losing to New Castle 69 to 77. The Boys team took home several first place finishes including the 200 Yard Medley Relay Team made up of: Eli Bymaster (backstroke,) Quaid Mull (breastroke,) Aaron Turner (butterfly,) and Bryce LaMar (freestyle.) Aaron Turner also took first place in the 100 meter I.M. and 50 yard butterfly. Bryce LaMar took first place in the 50 freestyle and 100 freestyle. Quaid Mull too second place in the 50 yard freestyle and had an extremely close second place finish in breast stroke to New Castle's Paul Huynh who finished first a half second ahead. The 200 freestyle relay team made up of: Eli Bymaster, Quaid Mull, Aaron

Turner and Bryce LaMar also won first place for the boys team.

The Girls Jr. High Swim team lost to New Castle's strong girls team 35 to 134, but had several personal best finishes. Olivia Klein took second place in the 100 yard freestyle.
