Join the hunt for the hidden egg in the Tiger Library each day this week. Congratulations to **Kim Lehman** and **Kent Caudill** for finding the egg


on Tuesday. If you find the egg while in the library, bring it to Mrs. Isaacs for a prize.

TRACK & FIELD

HHS Track Squads Win County Titles

Both girls and boys won Wayne County track and field championships for Hagerstown Tuesday on the Tigers' home track. The girls' meet saw top performances by HHS in sprints and field events, while the boys excelled in relays and throws.

Ashley Vinson was a double winner in the 100 and 200 and also ran a leg on the winning 4 x 100 relay along with Olivia Sullivan, Jessica Swimm, and Madison Pruitt. Other event winners included Swimm, 300 LH, Ella Nicholson, 800, Pruitt, high jump, Kassidy Oliger, disc, and Kaelynn Shultz, shot. For the boys, Ryan Golliher won both shot and disc, with a personal best toss of 153-1.5 in disc, while Jaylon Favorite won the 200, Logan Tuttle the 800, Holden Robinson the 300 IH, and all three relay teams prevailed. Final scores for girls: HHS 101, Centerville 84.5, Lincoln 27.5, Northeastern 13. Final scores for boys: HHS 100, Lincoln 56, Northeastern 38, Centerville 34. The Tiger girls are now 10-1-1 on the season, the boys are 12-0.
