# Tiger Results

## VARSDTY BASEBALL

A trio of Hagerstown pitchers held Eastern Hancock to just 1 hit as the Tigers improved to 15-1 after this evening's 12-0 victory over the Royals. Grant Vinson earned his 3rd victory of the season while Derek Davis and Noah Dale finished the near perfect game. Collectively the Tiger trio struck out 9 Royal batters while allowing 0 walks and just 1 hit.

The Tigers remembered the lumber as they amassed 15 hits. The offense was led by a red hot Mason Hicks who went 3-3 with a single, double, home run, 3 runs scored and 4 rbi. Cody Swimm, Collin Romack, and Derek Davis also added two hits each. Grant Vinson added 3 stolen bases and Cody Swimm another 2 to the cause.

The Tigers have tomorrow off as they head into Saturday's County Tourney where they square off with a young and tough Bulldog squad at 11:30 am in Milton.

## **JR. HIGH TRACK & FIELD**

Circumstances did not permit the last meeting of the junior high track squads at Blue River yesterday, but the teams did compete Tuesday evening for the TEC championship.

After two delays, the TEC was finally held. It was not ideal for the girls to compete at this level since the odds were down with key athletes out of competition due to injury. Nevertheless there were individual performances of note.

### **Scorers**

- Kasiti Ferriell was the conference champion in the 100 meter dash. She also finished 2nd in the 100 meter hurdles. Kasiti managed 6th in the 400 meter dash as well.
- Hannah Ridge placed 4th in the 800 meter run followed by Erika Grams in 6th.
- Erika Grams placed 5th in the 1600 meter run while Jenna Smith placed 7th, and both girls earned a PR in the event.
- The 4x4 team of Logan Klein, Kenzie Scholl, Hannah Ridge, and Kasiti Ferriell finished 4th.
- In shot put, Hannah Pyle placed 3rd and she also placed 7th in the discus throw.

- Logan Klein managed a 7th place finish in high jump.
- Trinity Payne placed 3rd in long jump.

In the end, the girls placed 5th.

The boys' also had some notable performances in the meet beginning with Mason Romack who earned conference champion honors in the 100 meter dash. Romack would also individually place 2nd in long jump and 3rd in high jump.

### **Other scorers**

- Lowell Berger placed 6th in the 200 meter dash.
- In the 400 meter dash, Carter Jenkins managed 4th place while Bryce LaMar finished 6th.
- Quaid Mull finished 3rd in the 800 meter run while Braydon Favorite finished 7th.
- With a new PR, Quaid Mull placed 5th in the 1600 meter run.
- The 4x1 team of Carter Jenkins, Caleb Ervin, Lowell Berger, and Mason Romack placed 3rd.
- The 4x4 team of Gary Lehman, Lowell Berger, Bryce LaMar, and Carter Jenkins placed 4th.
- In the discus throw, Bryce LaMar managed 7th place.
- Gary Lehman placed 4th in high jump.
