

Tiger Results VARSITY BOYS TRACK & FIELD Tiger Boys Second at Connersville Sectional, Nine Advance

Hagerstown's boys' track team suffered its only setback of the season, scoring 119.25 points and winning five events but placing well behind team champion Rushville at the Connersville Track and Field Sectional. The meet was conducted over two evenings as heavy rain and storms caused a delay and made field event competition unsafe on Thursday. Field events were completed on Friday, and though the Tigers gained ground on the Lions Friday evening, 18 unanswered points by Rushville in pole vault and better performances in both short sprints and long distances on the first day of competition gave the Lions the win. HHS finished its team season as TEC, Wayne County, Tiger Booster Invitational, and Park Tudor Invitational champions and with a cumulative record of 51-1, a school record for opponents defeated in a single season.

Nine athletes advanced to the Warren Central Regional for the Tigers, several of them event

champions. Ryan Golliher won both shot and disc, meeting the state standard in shot with a put of 53-11. Holden Robinson defended his title in the 300 IH as did Logan Tuttle in the 800. The 4 x 400 team of Jaylon Favorite, Tuttle, Dylan Napier, and Robinson also placed first. Napier advanced in high jump as well with a third-place finish. Robinson was third in the high hurdles but chose to scratch the event at regional to focus on the 300's. The 4 x 800 team of Braden Himelick, Adam Nadler, Quentin Osborne, and Tuttle placed second. Jadon Locke advanced to regional with a third in shot.

Excellent non-advancing performances were also given by Blake Creech in the 1600 and Adam Nadler in the 800 who each ran personal bests. Golliher, Robinson, and Tuttle all have good chances of advancing to the state meet, and the 4 x 400 team will be looking to set a school record and see if it can slip into the top group. Golliher will be the second seed at Warren, and Robinson the fourth though his season best time places him second among the field. Tuttle will run in an 800 race featuring eight competitors whose season best times place them all within about 1.5 seconds of one another.
