The type of work you can expect in these positions includes customer service, the movement of product displays and sidecounters as well as general organization and cleaning. A limited amount warehouse positions are also available.



Tigers take sectional. Finally!

In what felt like the longest game ever played, the Hagerstown Tigers emerged victorious over a scrappy Centerville Bulldog squad 3-1 to become the 2019 IHSAA Sectional 41 Champions.

The game began Monday evening at 7pm and concluded just after 6pm Tuesday night. Severe lightning and tornado warnings forced the game to

be suspended tied 1-1 heading into the bottom of the 6th with the Tigers about to bat.

Hagerstown starter Cody Swimm was credited with his 9th victory of the season pitching 6 innings striking out 8 Bulldogs and allowing just 1 hit. However, his counterpart Bulldog ace Dalton Stevens matched Swimm nearly inning for inning keeping the Bulldogs in the game. Stevens allowed only one Tiger to cross the plate in 5 complete. It was a very gutsy performance and is worthy of many accolades for the Senior pitching his final game as a Bulldog.

As play resumed, the game switched from a tough matchup of Senior pitchers to a battle of two fantastic Sophomores. Bulldog Cameron Newman and Tiger Dom “the bomb” Anderson.

Newman served the Tigers three strikeouts in the bottom of the sixth, but not before cleanup hitter Camden “Deno” Rhoades sent a fastball over the 340 mark in right-center field to give the Tigers a quick lead. With 2 outs, Mason Hicks blasted a double to the gap and on the next pitch scored on Clay Cochran’s second hit and second rbi of the game. Derek Davis followed with an infield single for the Tigers 4th hit of the inning

before Newman retired Brady Mcmillan for the final out of the 6th.

In the top of the 7th it was Dominic David Anderson taking the mound. At the plate was an always difficult out in Senior Peyton Hobson who will be heading to Franklin College this fall to play football. Hobson earned a lead off walk (his third of the game) followed by back to back strike outs from Anderson. The next two batters earned walks loading the bases. With the tying run on second base and a 2-2 count, the next batter grounded to short to end the game and secure the victory for the Tigers.

This game was a barn-burner and proved just how tough baseball in this area has become. Dalton Stevens was magnificent as was Tiger ace Cody Swimm. Then to see these programs trust the arms of two sophomores to finish the sectional final is very promising for the future of both programs. Centerville played a nearly perfect game and with the youth in their program it appears they are destined for a great run over the next several years.

One of the most difficult things to accomplish in high school sports is beating the same team three

times in one season. Especially when you're on their home field. This coach is very proud of his Tigers and can't wait to try it again next weekend.

Congrats to Coach Tracey Crull, Scott Crull, Jason Searcy and the rest of their staff and team on a tremendously played game.
