CROSS COUNTRY

Halcomb Wins County, Teams Second

Elijah Halcomb won the individual Wayne County title in boys' cross country for the second consecutive year while both the boys' and girls' squads finished second as teams. Quentin Osborne and Quad Mull joined Halcomb on the "All-County" team with top-ten finishes at fifth and ninth. Adam Nadler and Blake Creech finished 14th and 15th to complete the scoring.

Ava Moore and Ella Nicholson were "All-County" for the ladies, finishing fifth and seventh. The rest of the top five included Taylor Pass 12th, Haven Ragen 13th, and Jewels Warfel 15th.

The boys' overall record now stands at 23-5; the girls' record is 20-9.

VOLLEYBALL

The Varsity Volleyball team won its TEC opener at Winchester 25-18, 25-17, 25-13. Regan Tinkle had 14 kills and 9 points, Jessica Swimm had 10

kills and 7 points including 3 aces, Carli Morris had 8 digs and 9 points including 4 aces. Hallie Rogers had 32 assists and 8 digs. The Tigers are 12-2 on the season and 1-0 in the TEC.

The Junior Varsity also won 25-8, 25-18 raising its record to 9-1 on the season. Makayla Matanich and Terraina Haskett had 3 kills each.

The HS Volleyball teams travel to Parker City Saturday for the Monroe Central Invitational.
