Attention all Seniors! If you are considering pursuing higher education, you need to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). To help you begin this process, HHS is having an FSA ID Day next week during College Go Week.

Sept. 23: FSA ID Day for seniors during Tiger Time.

What's needed?

These are the items students would need to create the student FSA ID:

- Student's Full Name
- Student's Date of Birth
- Student's Social Security Number
- Student's Cell Phone Number (must be different than parent's cell phone number)
- Student's Email Address (must be different than parent's email address and we highly recommend it NOT be their @nettlecreek school email address because it needs to be an email address they'll have access to after HS graduation. So a gmail, yahoo, etc. is best).
- Student's Address/City/State Zip
- A charged Chromebook

If you cannot attend during Tiger Time, visit fsaid.ed.gov or stop to see Mrs. Arnold. She would be happy to help you!

To finish signing up, parents and students are urged to attend the Wayne County FAFSA Day at the Golay Center Monday, Nov. 11, from 3-7pm. Parents will create their own number. That, along
