## **CROSS COUNTRY**

### **CC Teams Perform Well at East Central**

Hagerstown's boys' cross country squad placed second in the Division I (Large School) category and second overall at the twelve-team East Central Invitational. The Lady Tigers ran to a fourth-place finish in the D-I race and sixth overall. Both teams posted season best team averages and many personal and season bests were attained.

Eli Halcomb again paced the boys, running a season-best 17:02 and finishing fourth. The rest of the top five all placed in the top 20 as well: Quentin Osborne 9th, Quaid Mull 12th, Blake Creech 16th, and Adam Nadler 20th. Ava Moore was top performer for the girls, placing 18th in a personal best time of 22:55. Others scoring were Taylor Pass 21st, Ella Nicholson, 22nd, Jewels Warfel 24th, and Jenna Smith 25th.

Coach Kent Gray commented on the meet, "We showed good improvement today and raced for every spot. Quaid Mull was especially impressive in running an 18:25. East Central's coach asked us to score in the large-school division to improve

competition there. Our boys would have easily won the small-school division and our girls would have been third, but the competition was good for us. Batesville ran away with both races as expected; their boys are in the top 25 in the entire state right now.”
