## 8th Graders Give USA Average Marks on Women's Rights

After analyzing and discussing the list of grievances from the "Declaration of Sentiments and Resolutions" from the 1848 Women's Rights Convention held at Seneca Falls, New York, 8th grade social studies students rated the United State on progress made in women's rights over the past 172 years. The United States graded out at about a C+ with consensus that much progress has been made, but much work is yet to be done. Students noted positives in voting, property, education, and divorce rights and opportunities, but also noted negatives in access to some careers, political representation, leadership roles, wages, and a continued double standard. 
