Though the Tigers did not have entries in all events, they performed well in the field of eleven schools, winning three events on the boys' side and placing many athletes in the top ten. Top performances for the boys were wins by Eli Halcomb in the 3200, Jacob Henley in the 60 Hurdles, and the 4 x 800 team of Adam Nadler, Blake Creech, Quentin Osborne, and Halcomb. The best finish for the girls was second in the 4 x 800 - team members were Jewels Warfel, Ella Nicholson, Taylor Pass and Ava Moore.
