RETURN TO IN-PERSON INSTRUCTION PLAN UPDATE

Dr. Barrentine explained that we are required to update this plan as needed. He wants the students in front of teachers as much as possible. This update will go into effect on Monday, August 23, 2021.

This update includes metrics that if the Jr. Sr. High School would see six (6) positive COVID cases or the Elementary would see seven (7) positive COVID cases or we have fifteen percent (15%) of the school population in quarantine, we would move to a mask mandate for a two week period. At the end of that two weeks, we will re-evaluate and make a decision whether the mask mandate needs to continue or not.
