Qualifications:

- Prior experience in coaching as, at minimum, an assistant at the varsity level
- A strong commitment to player development, including the ability to communicate strengths and weaknesses to players and continuous improvement plans for skill enhancement
- A commitment to being a positive role model for all students, who develops an atmosphere of teamwork and sportsmanship in the program
- A commitment to the overall development of the student, with a strong focus on the academic progress of all student-athletes
- The ability to analyze opponents and create game-specific plans
- The ability to work effectively with a diverse population of students and parents, where the development of strong, supportive relationships is a top priority
- Taking the initiative to counsel all student-athletes on their progress and potential for the next level, including assistance in the recruiting process for all athletes believed to be capable of playing at the collegiate level

Preferred Qualifications:

- Competitive playing experience, with experience as a college athlete being a major plus
- Previous successful head coaching experience at the varsity level
- Possess a valid teaching license and certifications in first aid, CPR, and AED
